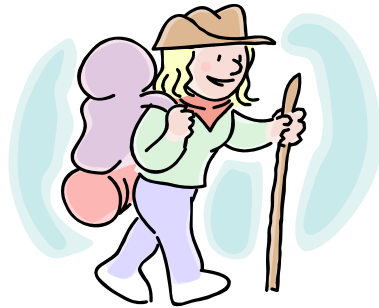


2008 Day Camp Sessions
